

**CONSENT TO ACCESS CO PDMP**

The Colorado Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (CO PDMP) is an electronic service provides a secure database of controlled substance prescriptions that have been filled in the past 2 years. It is required by law that before a physician writes a prescription for a controlled substance that they review the patient’s CO PDMP list. Suboxone is a controlled substance and thus accessing the CO PDMP record is an essential component to ensuring patient safety and compliance with rules of the program. It is a required standard for all physicians who prescribe Suboxone.

I have read the above information and understand that in order for the physician to prescribe Suboxone, they must access the CO PDMP report. I give consent for the physician to access my CO PDMP report as often as appropriate.
